Once-a-week Placements:

- You **MUST BE OVER 16** to apply for this type of placement.
- These placements are for any day (dependant on availability) until finish (either 4.30pm low season or 5.30pm high season – please check our opening times or ask)
- They are ongoing, and will be reviewed regularly. We may have to terminate placements after a certain duration to give others a chance to gain experience.
